EMERGENCY PLAN

In the unlikely event of any emergency evacuation when I have children in my care ie: gas leak/fire/flood, I would follow the following procedure:-

Get the children out as quickly as possible following the fire drills I have practiced. I would use the nearest exit possible (the front door, or the Rear door in the kitchen and Dining room). I am able to walk the children through the rear door and round the side of the house, from the kitchen and Dining room to the safety of the street.

Telephone the fire brigade

Telephone children's parent/main carer or emergency carer if main carer unavailable

Inform Ofsted

I will always carry my mobile phone fully charged, the number of which has been issued to all parents. All parents contact numbers are also held on the phone.

Fire drills are practiced and recorded once a month and smoke detector alarms are checked (and recorded) to be working once every two weeks. A fire blanket is kept on the kitchen worktop at all times when children are present.
